

SYNASTRY REPORT OF MARC AND JENNY

Introduction

This report has been written to introduce you to the concepts of astrology and how to get started in relationship astrology. Astrology is a complex and meaningful science which takes years to study and apply successfully; however, we would like to whet your appetite with this report, and encourage you to deepen your understanding through other means.

Astrology is a study of the connection between planets and life on Earth. It is based on a concept that energy patterns form between other planets and Earth and that these energies affect our lives as individuals and communities.

An astrological chart, also known as a horoscope, natal chart, or birth chart, records the relationship between the planets and the signs of the Zodiac. Charts can be calculated for the birth of a person, a community, an event or anything that seems momentous. The horoscope is as individual and unique as a fingerprint.

When using these interpretations, please bear in mind that, inevitably, every chart will contain some contradictory influences, and as a result certain interpretations of different items in the same chart may seem difficult to reconcile. However, this may still be an accurate reflection your chart, as it is likely that you do experience conflicting desires, events and circumstances in your life. Usually it is the responsibility of an astrologer to synthesise these apparent contradictions in order to present a cohesive and realistic interpretation of the dilemmas of the chart.

Please also be aware of the fact that each person has positive and negative influences in the chart, and therefore in their lives. The challenge is to accept and overcome the negative influences, so that we can successfully focus on the positive traits. This report outlines the influence of both people's charts on each other. This is called relationship synastry meaning the comparison of two horoscopes and the correlations discovered. It is likely that the report will show both the strengths and weaknesses of the relationship synastry. Any advice given is meant to be an aid to a person taking responsibility for their own lives and their own choices within a relationship. The ultimate decision rests with each individual. Individual Relating Traits

This section looks at each person's individual relationship concerns in their own personal birth chart. Every individual brings certain needs and expectations into a union, which affect his or her ability to feel loved and supported. This in turn affects the nature and course of the relationship.

Traits of Marc

Venus is in the 12th House

When the planet Venus is placed in the twelfth house of your birth chart you're likely to enjoy your own company, perhaps even craving the peace and quiet offered by seclusion rather than the hustle and bustle of a hectic social life. Your friends and your life partner need to respect your need to be alone at times. On occasion you don't mind spending your time with one or two friends, particularly women friends, but "the more the merrier" is definitely not your motto. You're more likely to be an introvert than an extrovert, reveling in a fantasy world or in your secret pastimes. You love mystery and romance, and have more than your share of secrets, perhaps even investigating secret arts. The worlds of magic, alchemy and astrology hold a certain appeal, as do many of the occult arts. Your success in the world may be as a result of your investigation into the secret arts. Success may also come as a result of your work behind the scenes in your profession, or in an institution or charitable organisation. You have a tendency to delight in secrets. You need to be wary of secret enemies, in particular women.

Uranus is in the 7th House

The planet Uranus is in the seventh house of your birth chart suggesting that you've a need for unconventional relationships. Depending on other aspects in your birth chart, these relationships have a positive or negative effect on your life. On a positive note you attract an unusual primary partner, someone who is original or involved in an unusual occupation, perhaps even a genius in his or her field. Your marriage gives you just the right amount of freedom to pursue your independent activities. You also benefit from lively and unusual business partnerships, or a business partnership in an unusual project. On the other hand, you may experience misunderstandings and troubles through your marriage and business relationships, which can lead to separation and disputes, possibly even lawsuits. Perhaps your partner is cruel, or possibly you rushed into these partnerships with little thought of the consequences. If you've experienced troubles in your marriage and business partnerships, which have resulted in loss, then you would do well to avoid conventional partnerships in the future. You would also be wise to avoid legal conflicts, because you're unlikely to benefit.

The North Node is in the 7th House

Your North Node is in the seventh house and your South Node is in the first house of your birth chart indicating that you are destined to learn as much as you possibly can about relationships. You benefit greatly through your relationship experiences, both personal and distant associations. You may also experience a sense that many unions formed in your life are pre-ordained. You fare best when you learn to let go of ego-centred actions and become more focused on service to other people. You also benefit from choosing your marriage partner wisely, taking your time to consider the union.

Venus is in Pisces

With Venus in the sign of Pisces you're sympathetic and understanding in your relationships, often letting your kind heart rule your head. You are charitable and like to help others, perhaps even choosing a career in which you take care of those less fortunate than yourself. You feel drawn to nurture the underdogs in society, which is an admirable intent as long as you're careful to ensure that your trusting nature isn't being taken advantage of. It's important that you constantly remind yourself of your own personal power. This helps you avoid any tendency to put yourself at risk or fall into a victim role. This is also true for your primary relationship. You're a kind and loving person, and need to make sure that you enter into a relationship with someone who appreciates these qualities. Fortunately the planet Venus is honoured in the sign of Pisces. Therefore you're likely to eventually fair well in your primary relationship. With the right person you'll enjoy sharing inspirational activities with your partner, whether it be listening to beautiful music or visiting an art gallery, or taking a peaceful walk by the ocean.

Venus is Sextile The Moon

You enjoy comfortable relationships with other people because of the favourable combination of the Moon and Venus in your birth chart. A charming and prudent person, you enjoy the company of other people, and they respond favourably. You're likely to enjoy success in your primary relationship, choosing someone who feels comfortable and companionable. You're also likely to benefit from your relationships with women.

Venus is Sextile Mars

The planets Venus and Mars are combining in your chart indicating that you seek a stimulating and romantic relationship. You're charming and assertive, passionate and alive, and admire these qualities in a potential intimate partner. You love to share your adventures with your partner, and it's likely that your relationship will inspire both you and your partner to explore new territory. You need only be wary of holding unrealistically high expectations of your partner, as this can lead to difficulties. This is more likely to be the case when you're young and idealistic. You're liable to disappointment, perhaps even angry feelings, when your partner fails to live up to your expectations. You could also feel angry if rejected in love. Fortunately you've an irrepressible side to your nature, on which you can rely in times of relationship trouble. You're a loyal and fun-loving partner with an ability to balance intimacy with independence.

Venus is Trine Uranus

The planets Venus and Uranus are connected in your birth chart indicating that you value freedom and individuality in your most intimate relationships. In fact you're determined that your primary partner recognize your individual rights. You won't allow anyone to curb your sense of freedom. You're attracted to an unusual, active or lively partner, rather than someone staid. For this reason your primary partner is likely to be inventive, extraordinary or involved in an unusual occupation. This isn't everyone's idea of an ideal partner, but it suits you. You seek spontaneity and intellectual stimulation from your primary relationship. Depending on other influences in your chart, commitment isn't a major part of your vocabulary, and can be something that you tend to avoid, preferring to be "footloose and fancy free". It's likely that you're afraid of

losing your independence, or perhaps you simply don't like the confines of a conventional relationship. Fortunately you're likely to have many friends and potential partners. Your bright and magnetic personality attracts potential life partners like moths to a flame. You enjoy socialising and have a wide circle of friends, and believe that it's important that a life partner share your friendships. Your best friend should be your partner, as far as you're concerned.

Venus is Square Neptune

The planets Venus and Neptune are combining in a manner, which indicates disappointment in your primary relationship. The problem is that you're idealistic and unrealistic when it comes to personal relationships, lacking the discriminatory powers needed to form a steady and lasting partnership. This applies to both your personal and business partnerships. Consequently you often feel disillusioned and sorry for yourself, blaming others for failing to live up to your expectations. It's possible that your partner is indeed deceiving you in some manner, but it's also possible that you're not being honest. Either way it's likely that you're seeing your primary relationship through rose-coloured glasses, and as a result conflict arises because of your lack of discernment. You're caught in a web of fantasies and romantic illusions, either of your own or your partner's making. Coming to terms with the reality of your relationship helps you obtain a better understanding of your primary relationship, and prevents you from becoming disillusioned. Taking off the rose-coloured glasses means that you can make a proper assessment of your primary relationship. As a result you'll experience fewer feelings of resentment and disappointment, and won't be in danger of overlooking some major flaws such as drug addiction or deceit. With the right partner you'll enjoy a sense of peace and fulfillment. You may also enjoy artistic or spiritual pursuits together. You're ardent and loving, responding quickly to your partner's need. In turn you benefit from acts of kindness, love and appreciation.

Traits of Jenny

Venus is in the 10th House

When the planet Venus is placed in the tenth house of your birth chart professional relationships are important. Success and honour are likely to favour your doorstep. Both your career and your primary relationship are favoured by this beneficial placement of the planet Venus. Depending on other influences in your birth chart, you succeed in your professional ambitions and in attracting a primary partner of high status. It's possible that you marry above your station. You enjoy pleasurable professional relationships, particularly with women, and can create a harmonious and comfortable atmosphere in the workplace. This leads to greater productivity, either your own or other people's. Your professional attitude to work, and harmonious working relationships, usually results in good promotional prospects and increases in salary. Your career may be linked with decorating, beauty products, women's interests, personnel management or any field that requires teamwork. Your life partner needs to respect the emphasis that you place on your career and professional contacts. In some cases you may meet your spouse through your professional contacts, or share the same profession as your loved one.

Venus is in Capricorn

With Venus in the sign of Capricorn you're shy in relationships, slow to form friendships with other people but, once you've committed to another person, then you're steadfast

in your efforts to maintain the relationship. This is particularly true of your primary relationship. Not one to be distracted by romantic illusions, you may appear to be reticent, almost cold, in the first throes of love. This is partly because you're timid, but it's also because you like to weigh up the pros and the cons to any new relationship. You're a great believer in the adage "actions speak louder than words" and you like to observe other people's actions. You form relationships slowly, but they are enduring. Your heart doesn't rule your head, although you like to think that you've a good balance. This is fortunate because you're ambitious in relationships, seeking a partner who is of good character and good standing in the community. For these reasons you may have more difficulty in your relationships earlier in life, seemingly missing out on the flurry of social contacts being experienced by your more flighty friends. It's later in life that your relationships flourish and you're placed in positions of trust and responsibility through your liaisons with other people, particularly people in authority. It's also later in life that you stand to profit through your relationships, either financially or through promotions in your social standing.

Venus is Trine Jupiter

"Lucky in love and money". This could be your personal motto because the favourable planets Jupiter and Venus are combining to shine good fortune on your relationships and finances. You're fun loving, generous and popular. With your sympathetic and kind nature, you've a talent for putting other people at their ease. You're optimistic and talented, full of joie de vivre. Therefore you're likely to be surrounded by supportive friends, and many potential life partners. You're seeking a relationship with someone who will expand your horizons, perhaps even joining your travels around the world. You love to share adventures, philosophies and goals. Other influences in your chart may indicate that you prefer to keep the home fires burning, but it's more likely that you seek adventure and romance with your partner.

Personal Issues

This section looks at the interaction between two people and their two birth charts. It notes the nature of the relationship, whether it is likely to be a successful personal relationship or whether the forces at work are suggesting a less intimate bond. In other words how do these two people come together on an intimate level?

Jenny's Moon is Square Marc's Mercury

Arguments can cause upset feelings in a relationship with this combination of planets. All types of associations can suffer some setbacks under this influence, but personal relationships are particularly fraught with difficulties. Friction seems to result no matter how Jenny and Marc try to approach each other on intimate matters. Jenny and Marc's relationship suffers because of unspoken problems, or perhaps either Jenny or Marc speaks their mind too often. Either way the problem is communication. No matter how hard both Jenny and Marc try they cannot seem to understand each other's way of seeing things and how each other feels. Misunderstandings occur when Jenny expresses her feelings. Marc thinks that Jenny is expressing thoughts and ideas and is ready for a good discussion. Jenny feels misunderstood. As a result Jenny and Marc alternate between passion and rationality, having difficulty understanding the other person. Jenny and Marc's behaviour seems at odds with their needs, and they do not seem to be able to comfortably settle down in the relationship. On a more positive note Jenny and Marc may not mind a little friction in their intimate relationship. However, it's more likely that Jenny and Marc would both do well to work on their communication skills. As a result Jenny and Marc can develop skills which help to overcome the problems enabling them to better understand each other.

Jenny's Moon is Square Marc's Mars

In astrology Mars is the planet of drive and determination whereas the Moon is the planet of feelings. When these two planets form certain patterns the combination can be volatile. In this case there is a lot of friction in the relationship. Jenny is likely to feel overpowered by Marc. Jenny often wonders why she is so easily upset by Marc. No matter how hard she tries to calm her emotions Marc just seems to trigger heated feelings. Jenny feels a strong attraction to Marc, but she is also aware that this is a troubled association. It is likely that Jenny believes that Marc lacks sensitivity to her feelings. Marc also senses the friction, but is perhaps not so bothered by it. Marc is more concerned because at times Jenny seems like a wet blanket. Marc's patience is tested because he feels that he has to console Jenny's feelings before he can achieve his goals in life. Marc also feels a certain excitement in this association, but is aware that the tension can be an obstacle to fulfilment. If both Jenny and Marc are aware of the problems and face them with honesty then an understanding can be reached and a rewarding relationship result. When this occurs both Jenny and Marc begin to feel that their lives have become more effervescent with the advent of this relationship. This combination is most difficult for a deeply personal relationship such as marriage or a close personal friendship. It can be advantageous for a working relationship that requires a lot of hard work and energy. For instance, building a house together may be a good way of using the energy of this combination.

Marc's Sun is Conjunct Jenny's Sun

When two people's Sun signs are connecting in a positive manner it augurs well for any

relationship. However, it is an ideal combination for a close, personal relationship whether it be a close friendship or love relationship. There is an instant rapport and the two people seem to shine more in their own lives as a result of such a connection. Marc and Jenny enjoy each other's company and feel that the other person is giving something special to the relationship, adding a little sunshine to their lives. Marc and Jenny probably experienced an instant attraction when they first met, warming to each other's personalities. This is because Marc and Jenny have a lot in common and tend to view the world in the same fashion. Sharing a common purpose they work and play well together. It is easy for them to co-operate, creating harmony in shared enterprises and activities. In fact Marc and Jenny are likely to experience luck and good fortune in joint projects. There can be a tendency for friendly rivalry, but this usually brings out the best in both Marc and Jenny. All in all it is a very successful combination of personal planets.

Marc's Mercury is Conjunct Jenny's Venus

The combination of the personal planets of Mercury and Venus is a desirable one for an intimate union, and certainly advantageous to any association which requires harmony and collaboration. Marc and Jenny enjoy each other's company, finding it easy to co-operate and share their experiences. They are compatible. Conversation has an easy flow and pastimes are fun, free of the restraints that sometimes hamper clear communication. Marc and Jenny share an appreciation of the arts, perhaps even partaking in a joint creative or artistic activity. Discussions are harmonious because Marc and Jenny are so often in agreement, including money. They concur on how money is saved and spent and enjoyed. Marc and Jenny value the intellectual stimulation provided by each other. Marc, in particular, experiences mental inspiration from his association with Jenny. Perhaps Jenny is Marc's muse in some form of the arts. Marc gains confidence in his opinions and ideas as a result of his relationship with Jenny. In return Jenny appreciates Marc's intellect. Jenny feels able to relax within this relationship knowing that Marc encourages rather than criticises her.

Jenny's Venus is Conjunct Marc's Mars

This is the ideal combination for a love union because it creates a strong sexual attraction and compatibility. Jenny and Marc are likely to fall in love at first sight enjoying a passionate union, the type of love affair featured in romance novels. The durability of the relationship depends on other connections between Jenny and Marc. However, if the love union is long term, both Jenny and Marc can rely on the sexual attraction to help them through troubled times. Jenny and Marc enjoy spending time together, in particular welcoming pleasure trips, romantic outings and artistic activities. They may also find pleasure in a joint creative project. Marc is likely to be the more assertive partner, both in bed and out of bed. Marc enjoys taking the lead and Jenny is happy to acquiesce. While this combination is ideal for marriage or love affairs, it can also be a creative connection for friendships or work associations that involve working on an artistic project. However, it is important that both individuals remain focused on the creative project at hand unless a sexual flirtation is welcomed and appropriate.

Primary Forces

In addition to the intimate aspect of a relationship, there are usually a number of fundamental driving forces, which can be either major challenges or inspirations to the individuals involved. This section looks at how Marc and Jenny stimulate and provoke each other.

Marc's Moon is Trine Jenny's Saturn

A connection between the planet Saturn and the Moon is important. Saturn is the planet of commitment and stability and is often found in relationships that are long lasting. In other words a serious planet such as Saturn is needed for a serious, meaningful union. Marc and Jenny are satisfied with the relationship and are willing to persist through troubled times realising that the rewards are great. A satisfying long-term relationship results from their patience and persistence. Together Marc and Jenny are somewhat reserved, perhaps even withdrawing a little from society to enjoy the benefits of their relationship. They are aware that their relationship is one of the most important building blocks in their lives. There is maturity in this relationship. Perhaps Marc and Jenny have formed this relationship later in life when they can truly appreciate each other and the life that they are building together. Marc feels that Jenny is offering security and maturity, enabling him to mature in his emotional and home life. Jenny grows in self-esteem through this relationship, believing that Marc respects her integrity. On the whole this is a positive combination for an enduring, long-term relationship such as marriage.

Marc's Moon is Sextile Jenny's Neptune

Romance is a major theme in a union which involves the Moon and the planet Neptune. With this combination of planets Marc and Jenny both feel that they are meant to be together. Perhaps they believe that it is a union of their souls. This is the height of romantic love. Marc and Jenny intuitively understand each other and as a result their relationship proceeds from the start in a gentle and loving manner. They may simply enjoy relaxing in each other's company or together Marc and Jenny may enjoy creative and harmonious pastimes which enhance their union bringing joy and fulfilment. They could work jointly on an artistic, musical or spiritual project, or simply share an inspirational hobby. Either way, they are drawn to each other in a way that is not logical. At times they may even feel as though they have a psychic connection. Marc feels inspired by Jenny to the point of longing to be in Jenny's company. Jenny intuitively understands Marc's emotional needs and relates to Marc in a caring manner. This is a harmonious relationship. Problems can occur if Marc becomes overly dependent on Jenny. However, on the whole it augurs well for a personal relationship which thrives on mutual love and understanding.

Marc's Moon is Trine Jenny's Pluto

This is an intense and powerful relationship. Marc and Jenny feel a strong attraction to each other, one that seems to constantly draw them together. Sexual attraction may be powerful. Marc's and Jenny's deep feelings for each other need to be nurtured in a loving manner in order for the union to be long lasting. This relationship can be a positive or a negative experience, depending on how Marc and Jenny handle intense feelings. Some individuals thrive on intensity, while others feel threatened and powerless. Marc is likely to feel that Jenny has transformed his life in some way. It's

possible that Jenny has changed the way that Marc feels about the world, making him conscious of things that have been bubbling under the surface for a long time. Life is not the same for Marc once he encounters Jenny. Marc is able to see through the explosive behaviour to the true heart of Jenny and to nurture Jenny's goodness in ways that she has not previously encountered. As a result Jenny deeply appreciates the emotional support offered by Marc. This is indeed a passionate union.

Marc's Moon is Conjunct Jenny's North Node

Both the Moon and the Nodes individually are significant in relationship astrology. The combination of the Moon and the Nodes indicates that this is an important personal relationship, one that changes the course of Marc's life and deeply affects Jenny. Marc and Jenny feel strongly drawn to each other, perhaps experiencing a sense that their relationship was written in the stars. In other words they may feel as though they were destined to meet and form a union. Whether the path of this relationship is smooth or rough, Marc and Jenny's paths were meant to cross. The nature of this association depends largely on other aspects of Marc and Jenny's charts. Passion may ignite if the right ingredients are involved, or friendship may be most appropriate choice of relationship.

Jenny's Moon is Opposite Marc's Pluto

This is an intense and powerful relationship. Jenny and Marc feel a strong attraction to each other, one that seems to unconsciously draw them together. Jenny's and Marc's deep feelings for each other need to be nurtured in a loving manner in order for the union to be long lasting. However, this can be quite difficult for Jenny and Marc to achieve. It's not that they don't love each other, because they do care very deeply. The problem is that at times their intense emotions seem to erupt from nowhere. In fact the feelings have been simmering under the surface ready to be expressed at any moment. The pressure builds up quickly between Jenny and Marc and before they know it they are embroiled in an emotional drama. Of course this can vary, depending on how Jenny and Marc handle intense feelings. Some individuals thrive on intensity, while others feel threatened and powerless. Jenny is likely to feel that her life has been transformed in some way by Marc. It's possible that Marc has changed the way that Jenny feels about the world, making her conscious of things that have been bubbling under the surface for a long time. Life is not the same for Jenny once she encounters Marc. She may feel powerless, overwhelmed by Marc's volatile nature. The key is for Jenny is able to see through the explosive behaviour to the true heart of Marc and to nurture Marc's goodness. As a result Marc will deeply appreciate the emotional support offered by Jenny. If this does not occur then it is likely that Marc will feel angry about the constant demands being placed on him by Jenny. Marc will start to withdraw and become isolated, only initiating contact in the relationship when he feels at boiling point. The challenge for Marc is to maintain a loving attitude and to give Jenny time to learn her emotional lessons. This is indeed a passionate personal union and one that needs to be loving, otherwise there is a danger of abuse. This combination can also signify a secret love affair in which intense feelings are indeed in the background. It can also depict an intense working relationship in which power struggles abound, but it is more likely to point to a personal union.

Marc's Sun is Trine Jenny's Saturn

Many astrologers believe that a connection between the serious planet Saturn and a personal planet such as the Sun is important, providing the cement for a long-lasting

relationship. In other words a serious planet is needed for a serious, meaningful union such as marriage. It is certainly true that the combination of the Sun and Saturn is found in many, meaningful relationships. However, the harmful planet Saturn can also cause problems. The extent of the problems varies according to the astrological aspect. Certainly this combination indicates that Marc and Jenny both view this as a serious association, whether it is a marriage, friendship or a working partnership. Both Marc and Jenny are committed to their association. It is likely that they experienced a strong attraction in the initial stages of their relationship, and it is likely to be long lasting. When Marc and Jenny first meet they each know they have discovered a potential serious relationship, one to which they can commit and build on over a lifetime. If they believe in reincarnation, then it is likely that they feel a karmic attraction, a moment of recognition when they first look into the other person's eyes. However, the very qualities, which they seriously considered as attractive in the initial stages of the relationship, can become the source of friction if they are not careful. In particular, Jenny needs to be wary of becoming too critical and judgmental. Initially Jenny found Marc's personality traits to be worthy of a committed union. She admired Marc's qualities as complementing her own. However, it is easy for Jenny to forget this attraction. As the relationship develops she feels threatened by the force of Marc's personality and takes a superior attitude in defence. As a result Marc feels threatened, disliking the authoritarian side of Jenny. If Marc is not careful his self-confidence is whittled away and the relationship becomes onerous. It is vital that both Marc and Jenny work at developing a stable basis for communication and understanding in this relationship. If both Marc and Jenny work at maintaining their own self-confidence as well as mutual respect then they have the makings for a very successful marriage or working relationship. If this is the case they both benefit from the stability offered by this union, growing in integrity in their own lives.

Marc's Sun is Trine Jenny's Pluto

This combination of planets indicates a relationship, which is life changing, whether it be a friendship, love union or work association. Both Marc and Jenny feel a powerful attraction for each other. It is as if they are both compelled to relate. The nature of the relationship depends on other aspects of their relationship. It is possible that this relationship is a positive one for both Marc and Jenny bringing rewards and challenges that lead to greater fulfilment in both their lives. Power and wealth may result from this relationship. Both Marc and Jenny are ardent in their pursuits enjoying intense and fulfilling pastimes, which are ultimately life changing. However, it is also possible that both Marc and Jenny experience the less attractive aspects of this relationship. They may become embroiled in a struggle for dominance, their relationship resembling a battleground from which neither emerges triumphant. They can be either intensely loyal friends or formidable opponents. Marc feels empowered by this union, learning to rise to the challenges set by Jenny. He feels that life is more exciting and intense, thanks to his union with Jenny. Jenny is a powerful force in this union.

Marc's Sun is Sextile Jenny's Chiron

This is a life-changing relationship that results in both Marc and Jenny being presented with opportunities to heal past wounds in order that they may live fuller and richer lives. Together they enjoy a sense of liberation that comes from truly loving another person. Jenny is more likely to take the role of teacher or healer, having a significant effect on Marc's life choices. In this role Jenny is also challenged to take a long, hard look at herself before imparting her wisdom. The adage "physician heal thyself" could be a theme for Jenny. In return Marc learns much from Jenny's experiences and

insights, perhaps even discovering his true-life purpose. This is true for intimate relationships, and also for student-teacher and patient-healer liaisons. Either way this can be a gentle, loving union based on mutual respect and compassion.

Jenny's Sun is Opposite Marc's Saturn

Many astrologers believe that a connection between the serious planet Saturn and a personal planet such as the Sun is important, providing the cement for a long-lasting relationship. In other words, a serious planet is needed for a serious, meaningful union such as marriage. It is certainly true that the combination of the Sun and Saturn is found in many meaningful relationships. However, the planet Saturn can also cause problems. Certainly this combination indicates that Jenny and Marc both view this as a serious association, whether it is a marriage, friendship or a working partnership. Both Jenny and Marc are committed to their association. It is likely that they experienced a strong attraction in the initial stages of their relationship. When Jenny and Marc first met they each knew they had discovered a potential serious relationship, one to which they could commit and build on over a lifetime. If they believe in reincarnation, then it is likely that they felt a karmic attraction when they first met. Perhaps this was a moment of recognition when they first looked into the other person's eyes. However, the very qualities, which they seriously considered as attractive in the initial stages of the relationship, can become the source of friction if they are not careful. In particular, Marc needs to be wary of becoming too critical and judgmental. Initially Marc found Jenny's personality traits to be worthy of a committed union. He admired Jenny's qualities as complementing his own. However, it is easy for Marc to forget this attraction. As the relationship develops he feels threatened by the force of Jenny's personality and takes a superior attitude in defence. As a result Jenny feels threatened, disliking the authoritarian side of Marc. If Jenny is not careful her self-confidence is whittled away and the relationship becomes onerous. It is vital that both Jenny and Marc work at developing a stable basis for communication and understanding in this relationship. If both Jenny and Marc work at maintaining their own self-confidence as well as mutual respect then they have the makings for a very successful marriage or working relationship. Much of their success may depend on other supportive, positive connections between them.

Jenny's Sun is Square Marc's Uranus

This is a relationship full of verve and romance, particularly in the first throes of love. Jenny and Marc are attracted to each other from the moment that they first meet and continue to experience excitement and joy in each other's company. Despite this sense of adventure, Jenny and Marc may have trouble maintaining a committed, long-term relationship unless they both enjoy plenty of freedom. This combination of the Sun and the planet Uranus suggest more an erratic and thrilling relationship, rather than a stable one. This works well if both Jenny and Marc value their independence and have stimulating pursuits. However, the initial enthusiasm can fade if Jenny and Marc begin to experience the need to accommodate each other's needs and desires in this union, to the detriment of their own interests. If Jenny and Marc both like to maintain their individuality, the relationship works well. This is particularly true for Marc, who stresses his individuality and can be unwilling to adjust to the demands of a serious relationship unless he is given freedom to do his own thing. However, if Jenny feels the need for more security and routine, then this can present problems. Marc may begin to feel overwhelmed by what he perceives as Jenny's strong personality and may have problems showing a long-term commitment. Likewise Jenny may believe that Marc stands in the way of her expressing her true nature. Either way this association brings

something new and original into Jenny and Marc's lives and they both feel enlivened as a result. The long-term success of this union may depend on other connections between Jenny and Marc's astrology charts.

Marc's Mercury is Trine Jenny's Jupiter

This is a positive combination of the planets Mercury and Jupiter and provides inspiration in any relationship whether it is a friendship, work association or more intimate union. Both Marc and Jenny discover new worlds through their association. They enjoy broadening their minds through overseas travel or by learning about different cultures in books and study courses. Philosophy, metaphysics and religion are topics of conversation, which stimulate and expand their minds. Jenny's Mercury is Trine Marc's North Node

The North Node is a significant point in relationship astrology, indicating fate in any association. In this case Jenny and Marc are destined to meet and learn from each. Perhaps they meet in a study group, as pen pals or at a college. Marc gains insight and understanding through his association with Jenny. Perhaps Jenny is a teacher imparting specific knowledge, or maybe Jenny's presence communicates certain messages that are valuable for Marc's life lessons. Either way Jenny and Marc are comfortable interacting with each other. Depending on aspects of Jenny and Marc's birth charts, this association indicates an intellectual rapport rather than a passionate or emotional bond.

Jenny's Mercury is Square Marc's Jupiter

This combination of the planets Mercury and Jupiter can indicate a relationship in which both Jenny and Marc are inspired by the meeting of two minds. However, it is important that they show some restraint in their activities. When Jenny and Marc get together they are both eager to discover new worlds. They enjoy broadening their minds through overseas travel or by learning about different cultures in books and study courses. Philosophy, metaphysics and religion are topics of conversation which stimulate and expand their minds. It is also possible that Jenny and Marc pursue activities connected with philanthropic or philosophical ideologies. In moderation this can be beneficial to the relationship. However, there is a tendency towards grandiosity. Both Jenny and Marc encourage each other to greater feats of learning or adventure without realising when it is time to call a halt. This can result in irresponsible behaviour. They also need to be wary of becoming too gullible in their efforts to follow a personal philosophical belief. It is important that both Jenny and Marc learn to temper their activities.

Marc's Venus is Conjunct Jenny's Uranus

This combination of planets indicates an instant and vital magnetism. It is the type of attraction in which Marc and Jenny take one look at each other across a crowded room and feel the sparks. Romance is alight and the relationship develops at a rapid rate. Friends are amazed as the couple's union becomes more and more intense. In the short term this relationship provides fun, excitement and stimulation for both Marc and Jenny.

The long-term scenario depends on other aspects of their relationship and the ability of both Marc and Jenny to respect each other's need for autonomy. It is all too easy for the initial flame to burn out of control. For this reason this combination of planets can be more prominent in relationships that contain the intrigue of a love affair, rather than the stability of a long-term union. Marc feels particularly struck by Cupid's arrow, ignited by the very presence of Jenny. He wants his love to be strong enough to keep the spark of excitement in the relationship. However, Jenny is hard to pin down and is likely to become bored once the initial excitement starts to fade unless she is given plenty of room to be independent. It may be difficult for Jenny to make a commitment to this relationship unless she is given the freedom to inspire Marc without feeling tied down to promises. A strong bond can be achieved if Marc and Jenny can find the right balance between intimacy and personal freedom. If this is achieved then they can both enjoy a long-term relationship full of joy and romance.

Marc's Venus is Trine Jenny's Neptune

Romance is the key theme of this combination of planets. Marc and Jenny feel that they have met their one true love under the influence of the planets Venus and Neptune. They meet, fall in love and create a union brimming with romance, joy and idyllic love. Whether or not this idyll lasts depends on other aspects of the association. During the course of their union they are able to interact in a loving and creative manner. It's also possible that Marc and Jenny participate in a joint creative and imaginative pursuit, inspiring each other to stretch their artistic talents. Perhaps Marc and Jenny follow a spiritual path together. Marc is particularly attracted to Jenny's artistic and altruistic nature. He appreciates all of the qualities that Jenny brings to their relationship. In response Jenny feels that Marc's support enables her talents to blossom. While this attraction is more likely to involve the love and devotion associated with a strong bond such as marriage, it can also depict a creative, artistic or spiritual working partnership.

Marc's Venus is Sextile Jenny's North Node

This is the combination for lovers. The North Node and Venus are both highly significant in relationship astrology indicating that this association was written in the stars. It is also likely that Marc and Jenny are in love, desiring to form a close and romantic bond, rather than remain friends only. Passion, romantic love and an intense desire to relate are central to this relationship. Within moments of meeting Marc and Jenny feel they have known each other for years. They enjoy each other's company, discovering pleasures in common. If circumstances dictate that their relationship can only be a friendship, they would be wise to tread very carefully. This is not an association to take lightly. It could easily take over Marc or Jenny's lives. In some circumstances this combination of Venus and the North Node can indicate an association formed for artistic or creative projects.

Marc's Mars is Trine Jenny's Jupiter

Marc and Jenny are able to combine their talents well under the positive influence of the planets Mars and Jupiter. Their association provides them both with a zest for life. Marc has the drive necessary for any joint projects, and Jenny has the know-how and planning capabilities. Marc and Jenny set goals, work towards them while overcoming obstacles along the way. Together they successfully achieve their ambitions. They enjoy collaborating, gaining the respect of each other in the process. Marc admires Jenny's inspirational ideas. In turn Jenny appreciates Marc's initiative and energy. As well as working together Marc and Jenny also delight in playing together. It's possible

that they enjoy sharing travel and sporting activities. Whatever joint project they undertake Marc and Jenny enjoy good fortune.

Jenny's Mars is Trine Marc's Saturn

Commitment is a central theme to this relationship. Jenny and Marc are striving to build something concrete whether it be a future together or work project. Together they have the strength and wisdom to achieve a shared ambition. This is not a flighty association. Both Jenny and Marc are aiming for a long-term and stable partnership. Together they achieve success in their joint enterprises in the long term.

Jenny's Mars is Conjunct Marc's Neptune

The glue that holds Jenny and Marc together is a focus on a joint artistic, spiritual or philanthropic cause, a shared idyll of how to make the world a better place. Together they share many dreams of how to improve their lives, their environment and the world at large. They are a creative duo, never short of ideas and with the ability to inspire. Depending on other aspects of their personalities they may or may not have the stability and endurance to create something concrete. Jenny is likely to be the leader, the person with the drive which enables them to achieve these dreams. Marc is the creative ideas person who inspires Jenny. If Jenny and Marc fail to share a common dream, then this relationship is likely to lack direction and Jenny and Marc slowly drift apart. They have difficulty maintaining a momentum necessary for a long-term bond. For this reason this combination of planets may indicate a relationship based on a shared project or past-time rather than an intimate lovers' bond. For instance Jenny and Marc may share a friendship, enjoying martial arts as a shared activity.

Marc's Mars is Conjunct Jenny's North Node

This combination of the planet Mars and the North Node indicates a fiery and fated relationship. This association makes a strong impact on both Marc and Jenny whether they are lovers or enemies. It is also possible that Marc and Jenny are involved in a dramatic or energetic project together. Whatever the path of this relationship, it is destined to change the course of their lives, in particular that of Jenny. Passion and an intense desire to relate may be central to this relationship. However, it is also possible that arguments and violence are at the core of this association. The challenge for both Marc and Jenny is to keep this association lively and positive so that fate can play its hand for the best possible outcome. In fact Jenny may benefit directly through the role that Marc plays in her life.

Marc's Jupiter is Conjunct Jenny's Saturn

A strong bond is formed as a result of this combination of the planets Jupiter and Saturn, in which both Marc and Jenny learn a great deal from each other. In many ways Marc and Jenny take an opposing approach to their relationship. Marc is more adventurous, keen to explore new territories. He takes a somewhat philosophical approach to this relationship. On the other hand Jenny is cautious, often taking a slower

and more practical outlook. Fortunately they enjoy these opposing qualities, finding equilibrium in their relationship. Jenny finds her day enlivened by Marc's personality. In turn Marc enjoys having a stable and patient companion to bounce his ideas off. Jenny learns much from Marc's wisdom, gaining a greater understanding of her own nature. Together Marc and Jenny can achieve much success in either their personal lives or a joint project.

Marc's Jupiter is Sextile Jenny's Uranus

Spiritual and philosophical interests could be at the centre of this relationship. Marc and Jenny enjoy a meeting the meeting of two minds. They are excited by each other's innovative ideas, perhaps sharing a common creative project. Their relationship follows an erratic course, but they are both happy with the stimulation and excitement. They enjoy a non-orthodox association, spurning a more traditional one. Jenny is excited by Marc's keen interest in her ideas. She appreciates the freedom of expression and exchange of ideas. This is an intellectual connection and therefore is more likely to benefit a friendship rather than a lover's union.

Marc's Jupiter is Trine Jenny's Pluto

Marc and Jenny are rejuvenated through their relationship. Life takes on a new glow from their first moment of meeting. In each other Marc and Jenny have found a soul-mate, someone who understands them at a very deep, metaphysical level. As the relationship develops both Marc and Jenny are challenged to reach deep within themselves in order to change and grow. Depending on their individual traits they can either enjoy this process of change or they can resist. Either way they are being dared to view their lives in a different and broader manner. Marc and Jenny encourage each other in this growth process through co-operation and understanding. Together they feel able to overcome all obstacles. As a result it is likely that, through this union, both Marc and Jenny begin to lead more creative lives.

Marc's Jupiter is Trine Jenny's North Node

The North Node indicates a significant and ordained contact. The planet Jupiter casts a beneficial influence. Therefore this is a positive and uplifting combination for any relationship. Marc and Jenny enjoy each other's company, both benefiting from the joy that is destined to enter their lives through this liaison. It is possible that Marc and Jenny meet while travelling, at a place of higher learning, in a sports arena or through a philosophical or religious organisation. Together they enjoy exploring any or all of these avenues of joint interests. Fate has smiled on this relationship.

Marc's Jupiter is Opposite Jenny's Neptune

However, as the relationship develops the novelty wears off and conflict arises. At first Marc and Jenny may not be aware of the deterioration of this side of their association. It

Marc's Saturn is Trine Jenny's Ascendant

Of course not everyone is seeking long-term commitment, but for those who are Saturn is a welcome sign. Of course they may both agree that their union was destined to be for a short period only.

Marc's Uranus is Conjunct Jenny's Neptune

This combination of the planets Uranus and Neptune does not necessarily indicate a personal relationship, but rather an impersonal type of association. Either way, it is likely that life can be approached in a new and imaginative fashion for Marc and Jenny as a result of this union. Together they stimulate growth and change in each other. Marc is particularly interested in keeping this association fresh and alive. He finds Jenny's ideas and opinions intellectually stimulating, prompting his own creative ideas and shared activities. Jenny's imagination is more to the fore in this relationship. She is able to express a more intuitive side of herself. Together Marc and Jenny share insights and this encourages their ingenuity.
